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## BOCCI 21 SERIES

Bocci, a young contemporary design and manufacturing house based in Vancouver, Canada has extended its chandelier collection with a new series of innovative lighting pendants, called 21, designed to be clustered together in large clumps.

“Bocci has been extremely successful with its first piece, the 14, especially with large custom chandelier fabrications,” says creative director Omer Arbel. “The 21 is a more emotional exploration of the custom chandelier medium.” Produced using thin wall raw porcelain and blown Borosilicate glass, the 21, which is inspired by the sporadic arrangement that barnacles make on a rock surface, features thin sheets of raw white porcelain wrapped around frosted blown Borosilicate glass trumpet shapes. The result is a contrast between an organic diffused light passing through the translucent white porcelain skin and a sharp, crisp light passing through the frosted Borosilicate component, visible on the interior of each pendant.

The fabrication process ensures that every individual 21 pendant is completely unique from any other 21 pendant ever produced. “Traditionally porcelain is slip cast or sculpted into very specific forms,” says Arbel. “We have developed a fabrication method that yields different forms in every iteration. The material is allowed to bend and fold according to its own intrinsic logic, thus every piece produced is original.”
